Logging in, logging out

- As a matter of security and data privacy, log in when arrive at your desk, log out when you leave your desk – especially if you work with student medications and other private data (similar to what happens at a doctor's office)
- Do not allow others to enter data using your login as the records will be stamped inappropriately with your JMC username
- Everyone should log in with their own JMC username and password

Practical Setup for Working with Student Medications Administration Tracking

- Have everything in one place
 - Medications to distribute
 - Computer for logging medication distributions
 - When you give a med, click it in (takes a matter of seconds)
 - Paper-based log (if used)
- Staff should log in, log out as they rotate through a shared station
- If more than one station is involved, make sure to refresh screens from time to time



Medications Tab

Entering the medication for the student

- Add Row / Edit
- Select the med from webcombo box
 - Can select by typing all or part of medication name
 - Includes prescription strength





Medications Tab

Entering the medication for the student (continued)


Selecting the med from webcombo box

- What if the medication is not listed?
- Can add User-defined meds
 - Define Medications (coming soon to a slide near you)



Medications Tab

- Entering the medication for the student (continued)
- Specify the Threshold
 - What is a threshold? How low do you wish to allow the inventory for this medication to get before you contact the parents to bring more medication for the student





Medications Tab

- Entering the medication for the student (continued)
- Remaining fields are optional (use at your discretion)
 - Pharmacy, Doctor information, Rx number...





Uses:

- Homeopathic Remedies
- Lotions
- Cough Drops
- Anything not in the FDA list
- Different naming of something in the FDA list (e.g. amphetamine salts)

Two Fields in Definition:

- Name
- Strength
 - Not used for inventory calculations
 - Basically a comment



Inventory Tab

Use **Submit Doses** button to record medications brought in by the parent or student. This will add to a student's medication inventory.



Inventory Tab

Use **Treatment(PRN)** button when a student is administered a medication as needed (PRN). This will subtract from a student's medication inventory.



Inventory Tab

You can create daily appointments for all of your students in the Appointments tab on the Edit Student Medications page.

There is a very handy page in the med log called Medication Appointments for a Day that allows you to track daily medication appointments. This will be covered in the video called Med Log - Setting Up Appointments.



Inventory Tab

Use **Other** button for various other actions related to the student's medications, such as:

- Lost
- Destroyed
- Returned to Parent
- Field Trip

These actions will subtract from a student's medication inventory.



Inventory Tab

List in this tab shows all inventory-related activity

- Doses Submitted
- Treatments (PRN)
- Other
 - Lost
 - Destroyed
 - Returned to Parent
 - Field Trip



Field Trips

To fully document medications given to a teacher for a field trip, you should use the **Other** button to document when the medication leaves the nurse's office for the field trip, then use the **Submit Doses** button to show when any unused medication was returned to the office.

OVERVIEW

The Health Module is school nurse software that ties together all of your school's health needs. This computerized health program allows you to easily manage, update, and query your students' health records. The health module allows you to see up-to-date parent contact information, health history, office visit logs, student medication logs, student medical emergency plans, and immunizations. In addition, parents can review their student's conditions, medicines and insurance in Student Information Forms. These forms are easily created in the Attendance module. The student's health information is stored in five categories:
