### Attendance and Period Attendance Modules

- Full/half day (Attendance)
- Period Attendance
- Period Attendance Conversion to Full/half day attendance Nightly automatic attendance submission via ADVISER API



# Attendance module is considered a core module

- Included in software for all clients
- Includes:
  - Full day/half day attendance data entry and reports
  - Student Lists (query)
  - Mailing Labels
  - Attendance Drop, Add, Re-enter
  - Calendar Related
  - Staff Related

### ADVISER Attendance Overview



Period Attendance is a module that allows for attendance to be taken by class period Most middle and high schools use this for detailed attendance. Attendance is taken during each class period by the teacher of a course



Attendance vs. Period Attendance

- Elementary schools use Period Attendance module for tracking student attendance (2 periods, full/half day)
- Most middle and high schools use Period Attendance for detailed attendance.
  - For state reporting (e.g. ADVISER), Full/half day is generally required, so if school is using period attendance it must be converted to full/half day attendance

In the example on the left, if a student is marked as absent for a period with reason "SchoolActivi" or "College Visit", since these are unchecked for the conversion they will not be included.

Common to have some activities like these not count as in half/full day attendance for state reporting or other purposes.

### Period Attendance – Data – Edit Reasons and Cutoffs

### Cutoffs – designate for each grade minimum number of periods of period attendance needed to constitute half and full days.

In the example on the left, a student must have at least 5 periods of absence in order for it to count as a full day of converted attendance, or they must have a at least 3 periods of absence in order for it to count as a half day of converted attendance.

Note: your local school district may specify these cutoffs however they wish.

Note: the periods of absence must be within the same day. In other words, a few period of absence here and there across more than one day do not accumulate to become a half or full day of converted absence in this process.

Nightly automatic attendance submission via ADVISER API

- NDE wants at least half/full day attendance but will accept period attendance as well.
  - Period Attendance is not used in your ADVISER portal for attendance calculations and reports.
  - Once enabled, attendance events (absences and/or tardies) will be submitted to ADVISER at approximately 9PM each evening.
  - If either Attendance or Period Attendance are edited in JMC, the attendance events for that day will get resubmitted that evening.
