

JMC WISEdata 2018–19 Updates Part 8: Course Based CTE

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Overview



- JMC has released a series of videos and documentation updates in October and early November.
- The videos will be short and will cover various small portions of WISEdata updates for 2018-19.



Course-based CTE reporting will be established based on students taking courses that are associated with CTE via the state course code tied to the course.

Some additional course/section data elements will also need to be designated for the CTE courses as well.

Also, CTE courses sections with a mix of CTE participants/concentrators and nonparticipants will need to be split into two separate course sections for correct WISEdata submission.




State Course Codes associate a course with CTE

For CTE courses the state course code is also associated with Career Pathways

You must designate at least one Career Pathway for your CTE course





Career Education Data Reporting

This diagram outlines the specific data reporting elements required for Career Education reporting. Career Education consists of College and Career Readiness (CCR) and Career and Technical Education (CTE) data reporting. Starting school year 2018-19, all public school districts will be required to submit the data found in both the yellow and green regions for students in grades 9-12 in order to satisfy CCR requirements. Additionally, districts who receive Carl Perkins funding are required to submit data found in the blue region for students in grades 11-12. 

Career Education Program For a CTE course you will need to specify a Career Education Program in the State Specific – Section tab. Either a certified or non certified program may be selected, but only one program per course section may be specified.


Assigned at Course Section level in State Specific - Section tab

Certificated Program Status For members of a CTE course with a Career Education Program specified for the course section, all students are required to be awarded a Certificated Program Status when they complete the course, or in other words when the final course grade is submitted for the term.

Certificated Program Status must be entered in the Comments column when awarding the final grade for the term.
