- Options for Maintaining and Submitting Special Education (SSEPA) via WISEdata Vendor must be certified for WISEdata JMC
- Can use JMC's special education history to create & submit SSEPA
- Additional Special Education Functionality in JMC
 - Edit Student Data page in Special Ed tab
 - Can use special education note to display current IEP or other pertinent data
 - Includes option to share with teachers



If something changes in the student's special education services, *cap off* the first record and start a second SSEPA record for this student.

To "cap off" the initial record, click Edit on Initial Special Ed History record

Enter Spec Ed End Date

Enter Reason Exited

Typically "Continuing in Special Education" Click Update button to save the changes for initial record



Next to create the subsequent record, click the
Add Row button to create the second record
By default new record will come up with same data except Spec Ed Begin Date will be one day past the exit date from pervious record
Click Edit on new Special Ed History record
Enter the changes in the student's special education services, then click Update button to save

Discipline and Special Education data are interrelated

- Some suspensions are only reportable if the student is "disabled" (special education)
- Some suspensions are only reportable if the student is "nondisabled" (regular education)



- Make sure your Special Education (SSEPA) data is up-to-date before submitting discipline data
- If reporting SSEPA from JMC, make sure the Special Education History data in JMC is up-to-date
- If reporting SSEPA from Third Party Software (Sped Forms, SEEDS, OASIS), then use <u>Wisconsin – Special</u> <u>Education History – Update Special History from</u> <u>WISEdata API</u> to bring copies of the students' SSEPA records into the JMC special education history
 - Note in these cases the special education history records in JMC will only be viewable, not editable. The Third Party software is where the edits should be made.

If checked, JMC is the "owner" of the special education (SSEPA) data and it is reported to WISEdata from JMC Special Education History records.

If unchecked, the Third Party software is the "owner" of the SSEPA data and JMC can only obtain viewable copies of these records via WISEdata.



- Two main reasons to get SSEPA into JMC Special Education History
- Makes student's special educations status known in JMC for WISEdata discipline reporting purposes
- Allows staff to view special ed info on students without logging into Third Party software



- Import Special Education History from Prior Year
- Found in Wisconsin Special Education History submodule
- Used to bring special education history from one year to the next
- Typically used just prior to the start of a new school year but after the prior year's special education recordkeeping has been completed (mid-summer)
- Note: This option is only enabled if JMC is the "owner" of the SSEPA records. This setting is found on the Ed-Fi Settings of <u>File - Administrator Options</u>
