What is Ed-Fi?

- Ed-Fi securely and seamlessly connects educational data systems.
- The Ed-Fi Data Standard is a set of rules that allow (previously disconnected) educational data systems to connect.
- Allows for rapid future growth by streamlining the process of adding new data collections to the system in order to meet state and federal reporting requirements

How Did We Get Here?

- Currently using file uploads from districts to MDE
 - Process initially developed in 1993
- Separate data systems
- Requirements to collect, and report, more detailed data
- Feasibility Study

2017 Legislation: Changes to Reporting Student Accountability

- Maintains current categories for racial groups
- Adds data disaggregation for ethnic groups:
 - 3 of most populous American Indian groups
 - 7 of the most populous Asian groups and Karen
 - 7 of the most populous Hispanic groups
 - 5 of the most populous African groups

What Will Ed-Fi Look Like in Minnesota?

- The current plan is to utilize Ed-Fi technology to transfer information from a charter school or district student information system (SIS) directly to MDE.
- This has the goal of eliminating separate file and spreadsheet uploads to different systems.
- Specifically, support the collection of student demographic and enrollment data.
- Phased-in approach over 5 years

- Identity: name, birthdate, SSID
- Demographic data: race/ethnic, ancestry, sex, language, economic status
- Program: EL, special education, 504, independent study, homebound
- Enrollment: grade level, last location, status end, enrollment and withdrawal dates

School Year 2018-2019

- Collect phase 1 data elements
- Pilot with Community of Peace Charter School, Minnetonka Public Schools, Schoolcraft Charter School, St. Paul Public Schools, and Worthington Public Schools
- Continue to provide data via current systems (MARSS WES, other uploads)
 - Comparisons/validations between current systems and Ed-Fi will be conducted

School Year 2019-2020

- Collect phase 1 and 2 data elements (all of MARSS data items)
- Goal of 50% of Minnesota districts report all MARSS data using Ed-Fi (phase 1 + phase 2 data elements)
- Continue to provide data via current systems (MARSS WES, other uploads)
 - Comparisons/validations between current systems and Ed-Fi will be conducted
 - Process to certify a SIS vendor will be established
 - Process to certify a district will be established

School Year 2020-2021

- Continue to collect phase 1 and phase 2 data elements statewide
- Goal of 90% of Minnesota districts report all data using Ed-Fi
- For districts that receive certification during 2019-2020, only report using Ed-Fi beginning this school year
- Continued comparisons/validations between current systems and Ed-Fi
- MARSS statewide edit continues

School Year 2021-2022

- Goal of 100% of Minnesota districts report all data using Ed-Fi
- For districts that receive certification in a prior year, only report using Ed-Fi
- Continued comparisons/validations between current systems and Ed-Fi
- MARSS statewide edit continues.

School Year 2022-2023

- Goal of 100% of Minnesota districts report all data using Ed-Fi
- For districts that receive certification in a prior year, only report using Ed-Fi
- Last year for MARSS-WES.
- Statewide MARSS edit continues.

MARSS Coordinators and IT Directors

- Data entry to SIS remains the same.
- Work together to confirm that the SIS is ready.
- Verify who will be responsible for correcting identified errors.
- Attend SIS conferences and check the vendor's website for information.

Supervisor of MARSS Coordinator

- Support the MARSS Coordinator and IT office by providing necessary resources.
- Provide time for learning the new Ed-Fi interface and correcting errors.
- Send them to training offered by the vendor and/or MDE.
- Identify other district staff who can assist in editing data.
- The time saved in extracting multiple files can be spent verifying the data.

District Administrator


- Support the technology and MARSS team in transitioning to Ed-Fi.
- Provide them the necessary resources and time to attend trainings.
- Help identify other district staff who can assist in editing the data.

Vendor and District On-Boarding Process

- Vendors will be provided a Sandbox in which to test their processes using test student data.
- The next step is the Staging environment where the vendor will use real data and more extensive interaction with MDE edit processes can occur.
- Once the district's data in the Staging environment has reached a satisfactory level of quality as determined by MDE, MNIT, and a designated District representative, MNIT will grant the SIS vendor a key and secret to the production environment.

Ed-Fi System Architecture Overview

- Validation Portal looks at the Raw (red) Ed-Fi ODS
- When user clicks Submit in Validation Portal, data is transferred to the Validated (yellow) Ed-Fi ODS.
- During the interim (starting 2020-2021) when we have Ed-Fi data submitted both in Ed-Fi and MARSSWES, this is also the integration point for MARSS data.

Validation Reports

- A validation report entry is added each time the district runs a Validation, with latest run on top.
- “Collection” refers to a group of validation rules. Right now we expect a “Fall Collection” and an “End-of-Year Collection”.
- The “Collection” label is a link to drill down to a list of errors from that validation.
- The “Export” button will download a CSV file with a list of validation report entries.
- The “Validate” button launches a new data validation process.



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

Validation Launch Process

The “Validate” button will launch a popup window which prompts the user to choose a school year (defaults to the school year selected) and a collection (defaults to a particular collection based on the current date) to run against the district’s data in the Raw ODS.

Submission Reports

- If the data error rate is less than 5% (configurable by MDE admin), then the authorized district user will be allowed to submit the data from the Raw to the Validated Ed Fi ODS database. The “Submit” button will then be enabled.
- The Submission Reports page shows a history of past submissions by the district.
- The district may resubmit their data to MDE any number of times within the collection time period.
- The “Export” button will download a CSV file with a list of submission report entries.
