MN MARSS 19-20 Updates

North American Indian Coding for Funding

From Tara Chapa (MDE)

- ▶ If the student is North American Indian or Alaskan Native (Q1), then ethnicCode = Y and indianIndicator = Y.
- ▶ If student is not North American Indian or Alaskan Native (Q1) and American Indian from South or Central America (Q2) is Y, then ethnicCode = N and indianIndicator = Y.

MN MARSS 19-20 Updates

North American Indian Coding for Funding

JMC Usage:

- ▶ If the student is North American Indian or Alaskan Native, then check both checkboxes.
- ▶ If student is not North American Indian or Alaskan Native but is American Indian from South or Central America, check left box only.
- ▶ If neither, check neither.

NOT N Am Indian, but is South or Central Am Indian	X

MN MARSS 19-20 Updates



Consolidate Kindergarten Grades from 25 to 10

Starting FY 2019–20 valid kindergarten grade levels will be KA – KK excluding KH, because it is too close to the grade level HK.

JMC currently only uses grade zero groups KA–KD, KG, EC, HK



MN MARSS 19-20 Updates

Kindergarten Schedule Indicator

Kindergarten Schedule Indicator B – Full-days, alternative days and C – Full-days, three days a week have been combined into Kindergarten Schedule Indicator B – Full-days, alternate days/three days a week.

JMC will not change anything on the Edit School Data at this time – you will be allowed to edit C codes to B codes as appropriate

Last Location of Attendance

The following LLA have new descriptions starting FY 2019–20:

- 05 – Never been enrolled in a school before, regardless of age
- 01 – Most recent enrollment was in a Minnesota nonpublic school
- 02 – Most recent enrollment was in a school in another state
- 03 – Most recent enrollment was in a school in another country
- 04 – Most Recent enrollment was in a school in another MN district or charter school
- 24 – Re-enrollment into the same school or inter-district transfer during the same school year

Status End Codes

**Use Status End code of 99 for the following

Title I School (Grade) Indicator

School Title I Indicator will not be required starting FY 2019–20.

Title School Indicator as reported in the Title I application will be used to determine whether the school is targeted assistance or schoolwide.

JMC Net Change – Beginning with our 19–20 software the Title I column will be hidden on Edit – Edit School Data

This means you can correct nearly all issues with your data before uploading your files to MDE.
